

Joshua 3

v. 2 after three days- always brings to mind the resurrection

v.3 ark of the covenant- 52” long; 31” wide; 31 “ high- weighed over 600 pounds

- contained tablets of the law; Aaron’s rod; jar on manna

v.4- 2000 cubits, over 8 football fields, over ½ mile

v.5 sanctify yourself

- they have already made provisions in chapter 1 verse 11

- now sanctify

- prepare for the Lord to move

- follow the Ark

v.7 the Lord begins to exalt Joshua

v.12-17 **as soon as priests step out**, God moves

- Jordan means judgment

- judgment held back at Adam

*(Rom 3:23) for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, **because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed**, to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.*
